1 RULES

- 1.1 The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in The Racing Rules of Sailing.
- 1.2 The prescriptions of the Royal Netherlands Yachting Union will apply .
- 1.3 The 'Rules for Championships Sailing and Windsurfing' will apply.
- 1.4 The "National Anti Doping Regulations for Dutch Sport " will apply.
- 1.5 For the Sonar class the events is an open event without spinnaker
- 1.6 The Sailing Instructions may contain minor changes to the Rules.
- 1.7 If there is a conflict between languages the English text will take precedence.

2 ADVERTISING

- 2.1 All boats, registered with the RNYA which are carrying advertisement are requested to show an advertisement certificate at registration.
- 2.2 Boats may be required to display advertising chosen and supplied by the organizing authority.
- 2.3 Competitors may be required to carry on-board cameras, sound equipment and positioning equipment on their boats

3 ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 3.1 **The regatta is open to all boats of the above mentioned classes.**
- 3.2 Eligible boats may enter by registration with the Organising Authority at the website www.deltalloydonk.org.



- 3.3** The fully completed entry form and payment shall be received no later than September 1. Payment is also possibly at registration (only cash, no credit cards or pin).
- 3.4** If at September 1st less then 10 boats have registered in a class, the organising authority may decide to cancel the regatta for that class. If so, this will be published at the above mentioned web site.

5 SCHEDULE OF RACES AND EVENTS

- 5.1** The regatta office inside the ISCM will be open for registration on Thursday, September 15 from 19.00-22.00 hrs, and on Friday, September 16 from 8.00 hours.

Registration and crew weighing for J-22 class will take place on Thursday September 15 from 19.00 till 21.00 hrs. and on Friday September 16 from 08.00-10.00 hrs.

Registration and crew weighing for F-18 class will take place on Friday September 16 from 19.00 till 21.00 hrs. and on Saturday September 17 from 08.00-10.00 hrs.

The first warning signal for the F-18 class on Saturday September will not be given before 10.00 hrs.

- 5.3 All Races will be sailed back to back.
- 5.4 At September 6 the final Schedule of races will be published at the web site <http://www.deltalloyd.nl>.
- 5.5 No warning signal will be made after 16.00 hrs. on the last day of the regatta.
- 6 MEASUREMENT, SAIL STAMPING AND CLASSIFICATION**
- 6.1 There will be no pre race measurement.
- 6.2 During the Regatta any boat and its equipment may be subject to examination at any time.
- 7 SAILING INSTRUCTIONS**
- The Sailing Instructions are available at the Regatta Office from Thursday September 15 19.00 hrs. (during opening hours of the regatta office).
- 8 VENUE**
- 8.1 Attachment I shows the location of the regatta harbour.
- 8.2 Attachment II shows the location of the racing areas.
- 9 THE COURSES**
- The Courses will be Olympic Trapezoid, or Upwind Downwind, or variations on these courses.
- 10 PENALTY SYSTEM**
- 10.1 For the 49er, 29er XX , F18 and Star classes rule 44.1 is changed so that the Two-Turns Penalty is replaced by the One-Turn Penalty.
- 10.2 Decisions of the jury will be final as provided in rule 70.5.
- 11 SCORING**
- 11.1 Four races are required to be completed to constitute a series.
- 11.2 (a) When fewer than 5 races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores.
- (b) When 5 or more races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores excluding her worst score.
- 12 SUPPORT BOATS**
- Support boats shall conspicuously display a flag of the country they represent.
- 13 BERTHING**
- Boats shall be kept in their assigned places in the boat park and harbour.
- 14 HAUL-OUT RESTRICTIONS**
- Keel boats shall not be hauled out during the regatta except with and according to the terms of prior written permission of the race committee.



- 15 DIVING EQUIPMENT AND PLASTIC POOLS**
Underwater breathing apparatus and plastic pools or their equivalent shall not be used around keel boats between the preparatory signal of the first race and the end of the regatta.
- 16 RADIO COMMUNICATION**
Except in an emergency a boat shall neither make radio transmissions while racing nor receive radio communications not available to all boats. This restriction also applies to mobile telephones.
VHF will only be used for safety communication.
- 17 PRIZES**
The responsible person of the winning boat of the championship acquires the title "Dutch Champion" , the medal(s) and the Blue Pennant of the RNYU.
Prizes will be given to every member of the crew of the first, second and third ranked boat in the championship.
- 18 DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY**
Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See rule 4, Decision to Race. The organizing authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.
- 19 INSURANCE**
Each participating boat shall be insured with valid third-party liability insurance with a minimum cover of Euro 1.500.000 per event or the equivalent.
- 20 RIGHTS TO USE NAME AND LIKENESS**
By participating in the 2011 Delta Lloyd Open Dutch Championships, a competitor automatically grants the Organising Authority, the organizers and the sponsors of the 2011 Delta Lloyd Open Dutch Championships for the and at their discretion, any (still) motion pictures, live, taped or filmed television and other reproductions of the competitor and its material, during the period he/she participates in the competition without any compensation.

- 22 TRAILER PARKING, DOCKING AND CARS**



All participants shall park their boats and road-trailers on the premises of the harbour Regatta Center Medemblik. Cars shall be parked in the designated parking areas near the Regatta Office. No cars are allowed at the dinghy park. Please follow the beach master's and the harbour master's instructions at all times.

23 HOUSING AND CAMPERS/CARAVANS

Regulations in the Netherlands prohibit sleeping in campers and caravans parked along public roads or in public car parks.

On the designated area on the premises of the harbor RCM campers sleeping in caravans or campers is allowed at cost of a fee of € 3.00 per person per night. The fee is payable at the regatta office upon registration.
